Managing your Recycling and Rubbish

Your day for kerbside collection is.....



YOUR BLACK BIN OR BLACK BAG

is for NON-RECYCLABLE waste & is collected EVERY 2 WEEKS on the same day.

YOUR GREEN BIN OR COUNCIL PROVIDED BAG OR BOX



is for RECYCLING paper, glass bottles and jars inc. lids, cans, tins, aerosols, plastic bottles and containers with film removed and Tetrapak cartons. Cardboard should be flattened. Items that do not fit should be put in a clear bag next to your recycling bin.

Any doubtful items should go in the black bin.

Clear and green recycling bags are available on request from www.camden.gov.uk/order-bins. This is collected EVERY WEEK on the same day.



YOUR FOOD CADDY

is for all unused food & scraps.

This is collected EVERY WEEK on the same day.

WHERE & HOW

- Please put bins out within 1 metre of the entrance of your property by 7 a.m. on collection day and no earlier than the night before.
- As close to the pavement as possible.
- At street level - Veolia can't collect wheelie bins from basements or up steps.
- If you have no space at the front of your property, put them on the pavement. Do not block the path.
- DO take bins off the pavement when they've been emptied. Don't leave them there all the time.
- DON'T let your recycling and rubbish overflow from containers.
- DON'T leave loose items and litter on pavements (see bulky waste over).
